## 30 day Prayer Vigil...

Begin whatever day God directs you...
Additional Scripture references optional...yet wonderful!

Day 1: (Rev. 3: 20)

"Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice...opens the door...I will come in...eat with him and he with me." (Ephesians 5: 1-2) (Ephesians 5: 8-10) (Ephesians 5: 14-16, 21)

**Day 2: (Psalm 5: 3)** 

"In the morning, O Lord, You hear my voice. In the morning I lay my requests before You and wait in expectation." (Psalm 5: 7-8 and 11-12) (Psalm 6: 4 and 8-10)

**Day 3: (Psalm 3: 3)** 

"But thou, O Lord, art a shield for me...my glory and the lifter of mine head." (Psalm 4: 3-8) (Psalm 16: 7-8 and 11)

Day 4: (Psalm 68: 1)

"Let God arise...Let His enemies be scattered..." (Psalm 68: 1-4);

(Psalm 68: 32-35) (Ephesians 6: 10-18 especially verse 13)

#### Day 5: (Joel 2: 12-13)

"Return to the Lord Your God with all your heart...rend your heart and not your garments...for He is gracious and compassionate..."
(Joel 2: 23-25) (Joel 2: 28-32)

#### Day 6: (Psalm 119: 105)

"Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." (Psalm 18: 28-30) (Isaiah 60: 1-3) (1st Peter 2: 9-10)

#### Day 7: (Philippines 1: 6)

"Being confident of this...that He who began a good work in you, will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus."
(Philippians 1: 9-11) (Hebrews 12: 1-2)

#### Day 8: (Hebrews 4: 12-13a)

"The Word of God is living and powerful...sharper than any two-edged sword...piercing even to dividing soul and spirit and of joints and marrow...a discerner of the thoughts & intents of the heart."

(Hebrews 4: 14-16) (Hebrews 4: 22-25)

## **Day 9: (Jeremiah 18: 6)**

"O house of Israel (O CFOers), cannot I do with you as this potter. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are you in My hand, says the Lord." ((Jeremiah 31: 3-4) (Jeremiah 31: 11-14)

## Day 10: (Isaiah 40: 31)

"They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength...they shall mount up with wings as eagles...they run and not be weary...they shall walk and not faint." (Isaiah 40: 28-30) (Joshua 1: 9) (Isaiah 41: 9-10)

## **Day 11: (2 Chronicles 16: 9)**

"For the eyes of the Lord go to and fro throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to Him." *King Asa was foolish and did not remain fully committed to the Lord* (2 Chronicles 7: 14-15) (1st Corinthians 2: 9-10)

## **Day 12: (2nd Timothy 1: 6)**

"I Paul, remind you Timothy, to fan into flame the gift of God which is in you through the laying on of my hands." (2nd Timothy 1: 7-9) (2nd Timothy 2: 1-5)

#### **Day 13: (Galatians 2: 20)**

"I have been crucified with Christ. I no longer live...Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." (Galatians 5: 13-16) (Galatians 6: 7-10)

#### Day 14: (Philippians 4: 8)

"Finally brethren, whatever things are true...honest...of good report... If there be any virtue...any praise...think on these things."
(Philippians 4: 4-7) (Colossians 3: 12-17)

#### **Day 15: (Numbers 6: 24-26)**

"The Lord bless you and keep you...

The Lord make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you... The Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace." (Psalm 1: 1-3) (Psalm 41: 1-3) (Psalm 41: 11-13)

#### Day 16: (Psalm 103: 1-2)

"Bless the Lord, O my soul and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul and forget not all His benefits."
(Psalm 103: 3-5) (Psalm 112: 1-9) (Romans 11: 33-36)

## Day 17: (John 4: 23-24)

"The hour is now when true worshipers worship the Father in spirit and truth; these are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is spirit...they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and truth." (Psalm 51: 11-12) (Ezekiel 36: 26-29) (Luke 11: 13) (1st Thessalonians 5: 19)

## Day 18: (Romans 12: 1-2)

"I urge you, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God. This is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world...

Be transformed by the renewing of your mind...you will then, be able to know what is the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God."

(1 Corinthians 6: 19-20) (Psalm 95: 6-7) (Psalm 139: 14-18)

#### Day 19: (Matthew 5: 14, 16)

"You are the light of the world...let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in Heaven." (Matthew 5: 3-16) (1st John 1: 5-7) (Psalm 27: 1, 5)

#### Day 20: (Hebrews 13: 15)

"Through Jesus, continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise, the fruit of lips that confess His name." (Hebrews 12: 28-29) (Romans 11: 33-36) (Acts 3: 6-9 *Peter and John did not have silver & gold. They offered Jesus.*)

#### Day 21: (Psalm 105: 1-5)

"Give thanks to the Lord. Call on His name. Make known among the nations what He has done...sing to Him...tell of His wonderful acts... Glory in His holy name...look to the Lord and His strength...seek His face always... (Psalm 47) (Ephesians 1: 3-10) (1st Thessalonians 5: 16-18)

#### 22. (James 1: 5-6)

"If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him...but when he ask, he must believe and not doubt..." (Psalm 111: 10) (Daniel 2: 19-23) (Colossians 1: 9-14)

#### 23. (Psalm 37: 23)

"The steps of a righteous man are ordered by the Lord and he delights in his way." (Psalm 37: 24-26) (Psalm 119:133) (Proverbs 16: 9)

## 24: (Psalm 100: 4)

"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with praise...be thankful unto Him...bless His name." (Psalm 50: 14-15) (Revelation 7: 9-12) (Psalm 63: 3-6)

#### 25. (Psalm 93: 1)

"The Lord reigns. He is robed in majesty and armed with strength. The world is firmly established." (Psalm 93: 2-5) (Psalm 8: 1-9) (Luke 1: 46-55)

#### 26. (Psalm 146: 5-6)

"Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the Lord his God, the Maker of heaven and earth." (Psalm 147: 5-6;10-14) (Psalm 146:7-10) (Psalm 30: 1-12)

27: (Psalm 29: 1-2) "Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His name... Worship the Lord in the splendor of His holiness." (Psalm 29: 3-11) (Romans 16: 20; 25-27) (Jude verse 24-25)

#### 28: (Psalm 92: 1-2)

"It is good thing to make music to Your name, O Most High...
To proclaim Your love in the morning and Your faithfulness at night."
(Psalm 92: 5-15) (Psalm 89: 1-50)

#### 29: (Psalm 139: 1)

"O Lord, You have searched me and You know me...You are acquainted with all my ways..." (Psalm 139: 17-18) (Psalm 139: 23-24)

### **30:** (Song of Solomon 2: 10-12)

"Arise, my beautiful one...come with me...winter is past...rains are over...flowers appear on the earth...the season of singing has come." (Matthew 4: 19) (Isaiah 55: 1-3) (Isaiah 1: 18) (Matthew 11: 28-30) (Rev. 22: 17)
